Ramsey County Sets Pair of Central Corridor Hearings

The Ramsey County Board and Ramsey County Regional Rail Authority have set a pair of public hearings to take testimony on preliminary design plans for the Central Corridor Light Rail Transit line.

- The first hearing is a joint public hearing of the Ramsey County Regional Rail Authority with the Minnesota Department of Transportation and Hennepin County Regional Rail Authority. It will be from **4 to 7 p.m. May 29 at Goodwill Industries**, 553 Fairview Ave. N., St. Paul. - The second will be a public hearing of the Ramsey County Board of Commissioners from **4 to 7 p.m. June 5 at Lao Family Community**, 320 University Ave. W., St. Paul, MN. NOTE: Ramsey County will accept comments on the preliminary design plans through the close of business June 12. The Ramsey County Board is expected to vote on the plans at its June 24 meeting. State law gives cities and counties 45 days after the MnDOT/Railroad Authority hearing to either approve or disapprove the preliminary design plans. If a local unit of government disapproves the plans, it "shall describe specific amendments to the plans that, if adopted, would cause the local unit to withdraw its disapproval."
